

## Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Yarding numbers remained steady. It was a very plain yarding of cattle, but despite declines in quality most prices remained similar to the previous store sale across all categories. The better quality end of the light weight yearling steers lifted 3c/kg, while heavy weight yearling steers dropped 1c/kg. Light weight heifers continued to improve in price from a low base price, but 3 score cows struggled to maintain last weeks price jumps.

Calves sold to 180c/kg and averaged 163c, while plainer sorts averaged 135c/kg. Light weight yearling steers hit 186c and averaged 169c, up 3c, meanwhile, D muscled lines averaged 144c, down 6c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed reached 174c and averaged 169c, up 3c, while those to restocker buyers hit 168c and averaged 165c, down 3c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made to 173c and averaged 170c, down 1c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to southern processors sold to 153c and averaged 140c, up 8c, while those to restockers earned to 150c and averaged 138c, down 1c/kg. The yearling heifers to feedlot buyers reached 156c and averaged between 142c and 153c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed topped at 156c and averaged 152c, up 15c, while a few to processors sold to 155c/kg.

Grown steers sold to 154c and averaged 148c/kg. The 2 score cows sold between 95c and 103c/kg. The 3 score cows sold between 113c and 115c while 4 score heavy weight cows made to 138c/kg.
