It was a mixed quality yarding with mainly cows penned. A full panel of export processors were operating on the score 2 and 3 cows, with the good heavy 4 score cows selling to 139c/kg. A few Brahman-cross bullocks made between 162c and 165c/kg, while most grown heifers met average demand from Queensland and southern processors. The major processors displayed strong demand for heavy weight bulls.

Medium weight grown steers sold to 165c and averaged 162c/kg. Medium weight 3 score grown heifers sold to 127c, while medium weight 4 score grown heifers made to 140c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score grown heifers reached 135c/kg. Light and medium weight 2 score cows generally sold between 81c and 94c and reached 103c, while those sold to restocker buyers were between 96c and 104c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows earned to 128c and averaged 112c, while heavy weight 3 score cows sold to 128c and averaged 121c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows topped at 139c and averaged 129c/kg. Heavy bulls hit 156c and averaged 144c/kg.
