It was a plainer yarding of prime cattle. The majority were drawn from the south west supply area with several consignments from central west Queensland. The usual export processors were operating with plainer conditioned cows and bulls dominating the yarding. Good conditioned grown heifers improved in price, while 2 and 3 score cows attracted solid processor competition. Bull averages declined from the previous weeks record high prices.

Medium weight 3 score grown heifers topped at 117c and averaged 108c, down 13c, while medium weight 4 score grown heifers reached 153c and averaged 140c, up 15c/kg. Light weight 2 score cows sold to 82c and averaged 75c, while bigger framed medium weight 2 score cows hit 105c and averaged 91c, up 12c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows reached 129c and averaged 117c, up 7c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows made to 133c and averaged 127c, unchanged in price. Heavy bulls earned to 181c and averaged 149c, down 7c/kg.
