

BLACKALL PRIME AND STORE SALE REPORT

14th MAY 2015

2456 head of cattle were on offer at the Blackall Prime and Store sale this week. With the absence of a major processor, prime cows saw a slip of 10-20c. Heavy steers were firm around the 200c. Heavy feeder steers remained strong with good quality pens out to 263c. Competition on young steers and heifers was quality driven and saw rates slip on last week with heifers averaging 175c and steers 210c. Bulls made to 197c and cows and calves to \$670.
