

## BLACKALL WEANER & STORE SALE MARKET REPORT 26<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2015

Blackall Combined Agents yarded a total of 3237 head of quality weaner and store cattle at the monthly Weaner & Store Sale on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2015. A quality yarding of cattle and recent rain in southern areas resulted in prices following suite with all other selling centres in the state and lifting by up to 20 c/kg across all classes. Weaner steers and heifers received very solid competition from both local and southern buyers while the usual feeder operators met a fully dearer market on heavier cattle also. Weaner steers topped at 286.2 c/kg and weaner heifers topped at 242.2 c/kg while cows and calves reached \$970.
