

## Detailed saleyard report - cattle

A reasonable quality yarding of cattle were penned for the first sale of the year. All the usual feedlot and restocker buyers returned to the market with some extra restocker competition at times during the sale. Overall, prices remained similar to last year for yearling steers and yearling heifers. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed attracted strong buyer competition. Heavier weight store cattle were in short supply.

Very light weight early weaned steers hit 406c and averaged 390c, while heifer calves made to 340c and averaged 334c/kg. Light weight yearling steers topped at 406c and averaged between 361c and 398c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers reached 378c and averaged between 339c and 357c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed sold to 338c and averaged 330c, up 1c/kg.

Light weight yearling heifers returned to the paddock at 344c, while most averaged between 304c and 334c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed hit 348c and averaged 346c, up 19c/kg.
