

## Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Strong Queensland, NSW, and Victorian processor buyer competition pushed prime cattle prices up by 3c to 11c/kg. The recent short supply of cattle and some rainfall across the western supply area resulted in increased export processor demand. Overall, the yarding of prime cattle was fair to good with prices lifting across all classes and quality of bullocks, grown heifers, and cows.

Grown steers topped at 293c and averaged 289c, up 3c, while bullocks sold to 293c and averaged 289c, 3c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers made to 283c and averaged 275c, up 8c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows reached 236c and averaged 223c, up 3c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows earned to 248c and averaged 245c, up 11c/kg. Heavy bulls sold to 275c and averaged 255c, up 3c/kg.
