There was a slight increase in the yarding, of 1,195 head. Bullocks, grown heifers and cows were well supplied in a good quality offering, with several runs of heavy cattle through the sale.

All the usual buyers were operating, however competition was weaker with bullocks and steers selling 20c to 25c cheaper, ranging from 240c to 291c with the heavy bullocks averaging 274c/kg. Grown heifers experienced similar losses selling to a top of 255c/kg. The cow market ranged from 12c to 20c cheaper, with the 3 score medium weights less affected, they averaged 228c, while heavy cows sold to a top of 243c/kg.
